#### **Section 1: Parties**

- a) The exporter should be the person or firm who makes the licence application
- b) The exporter's reference can be completed by the exporter
- c) d) The consignee is the person or body to whom the goods are to be sent. If the consignee is the same as the end-user, (d) can be left blank
- e)-h) The end-user details should be those of the person or body who will receive the goods for end-use

### Section 2: Goods

We need to understand what the goods are and to be able to compare them with the goods described the licence application. We need a detailed description of the main item or items. If, for example, the main item or items are accompanied by a long list of spares or accessories, you should indicate this, but it may not need to spell out all the items individually. If the goods are spares, components or accessories, you should indicate what they are to be used for, and describe clearly the item in or with which they will be used (e.g. turbine blades for XX engine for YY aircraft)

### Section 3: Purpose of the goods

If the goods are to be incorporated into another product, then that product - and its use - should also be described.

## Section 4: End-user undertaking

To be completed by the body or person, in the country of ultimate destination, who will make final use of the goods.

#### Section 5: Consignee undertaking

If section 4 cannot be completed, this section must be completed by the person or body to whom the goods are to be sent.
